About the Program

FLEXTALK STUDENT MENTORING is a free, student-led program for middle schools and high schools. Here it is in a nutshell: older students mentor younger students in "student groups" of 4-10 students with two co-leaders. The values-based curriculum uses 5-minute videos and simple discussion questions, all created by students for students.

Groups can meet before school, after school, or during lunch. Student groups meet weekly for about an hour, covering topics from www.FLEXTALK.org and optionally doing a fun activity together. Group members must commit to the entire semester and there are no fees for participation.

Administrators: Mentoring is awesome, and mentors should be rewarded! So should the graduates. We recommend putting on a banquet at the end of each semester, acknowledging both mentors and graduates of the program.

FLEXTALK STUDENT MENTORING requires at least two charter student mentors
